SUBJECT: NEW MEDICAL CLEARANCE FORM (STD 910)

The new Essential Functions Health Questionnaire (STD 910) is now available for departmental use for medical clearance purposes. This form was developed by the Task Force on Medical Clearance Options to simplify the collection of basic applicant information relevant to the health of persons who have been offered and accepted a State civil service appointment.

Departments may order the STD 910 from the Department of General Services, Office of State Publishing, either:

The order form is in pdf Fill & Print Format, which requires Adobe Acrobat Reader 4.0 to view the form; or
